## Executing the debrief meeting

The debrief meeting is the conversation the operative work team has after the work is done. The purpose of the conversation is to identify and share learning - what went well and what can be improved for next time?

The three conversations is one way to use the A-standard in practice in an operative setting. You can also do a written A-standard using the A-standard app, help sheet or other tools / methods.

### TRIP 2: Continuing best practice and using the A-standard

#### REFLECTION

Discuss with the team how you can continue your experiences from Trip 1:
