PRACTICAL TASK: OPERATIVE PERSONNEL AND LEADERS

Promoting good health through A-standard

The purpose of this task is to become better at using the A standard in everyday life to promote good health. The A-standard is a mindset and a method that helps us understand the task, identify risks, manage change and learn from the work we do. The task focuses on how we can identify and manage exposure that may eventually lead to work-related illness.

Trip 1

PREPARATIONS

The line manager is responsible for planning and facilitating the implementation of the additional package and practical tasks. Use existing meeting arenas such as morning meetings, 3 pm-coffee meetings or similar for planning, sharing experiences and summarising.

DESCRIPTION OF THE TASK

- 1) Choose a task or job you will be doing on this trip that involves the risk of exposure to benzene or other harmful chemicals.
- 2) Carry out a written A-standard related to the task or job you have chosen, where you focus on the planning: Which requirements and procedures are relevant? What measures do we need to take? How should we handle any changes?
- 3) When the job is finished, you summarize based on the questions: What was good? What can we do better next time?

On trip two, you will share experiences and continue to work on the topic.
